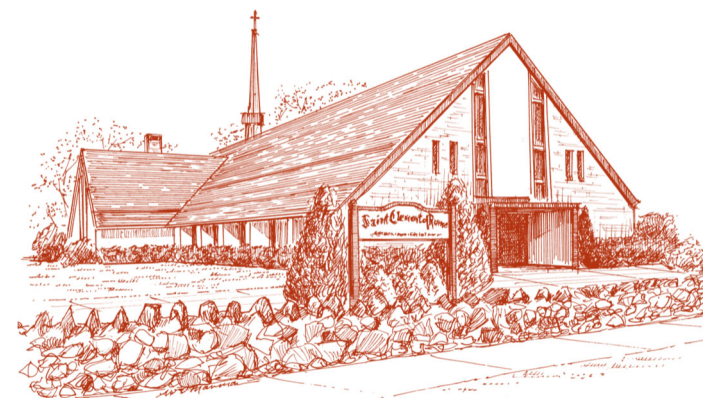

God will support you in your sorrow, and He will walk with you as you begin your journey through loss to healing.

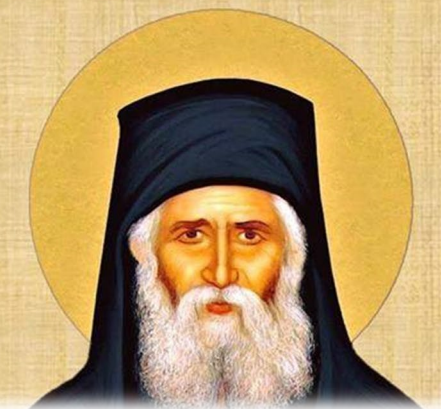
Meetings are led by trained bereavement facilitators. There is no charge.
