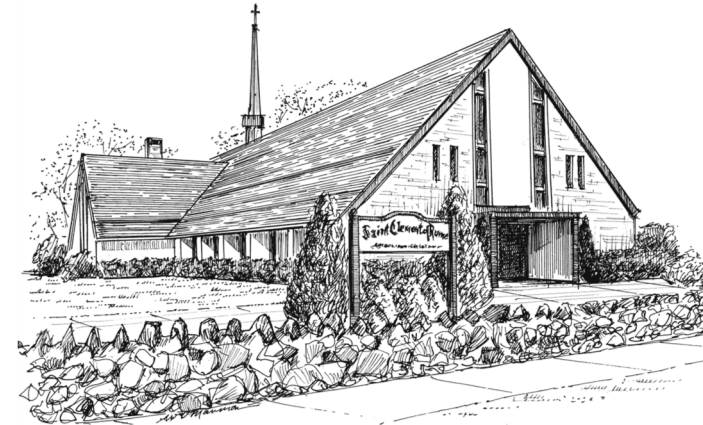

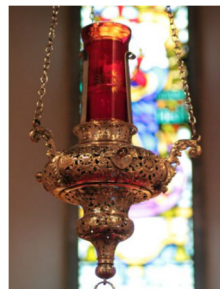

#### Hospital Visits

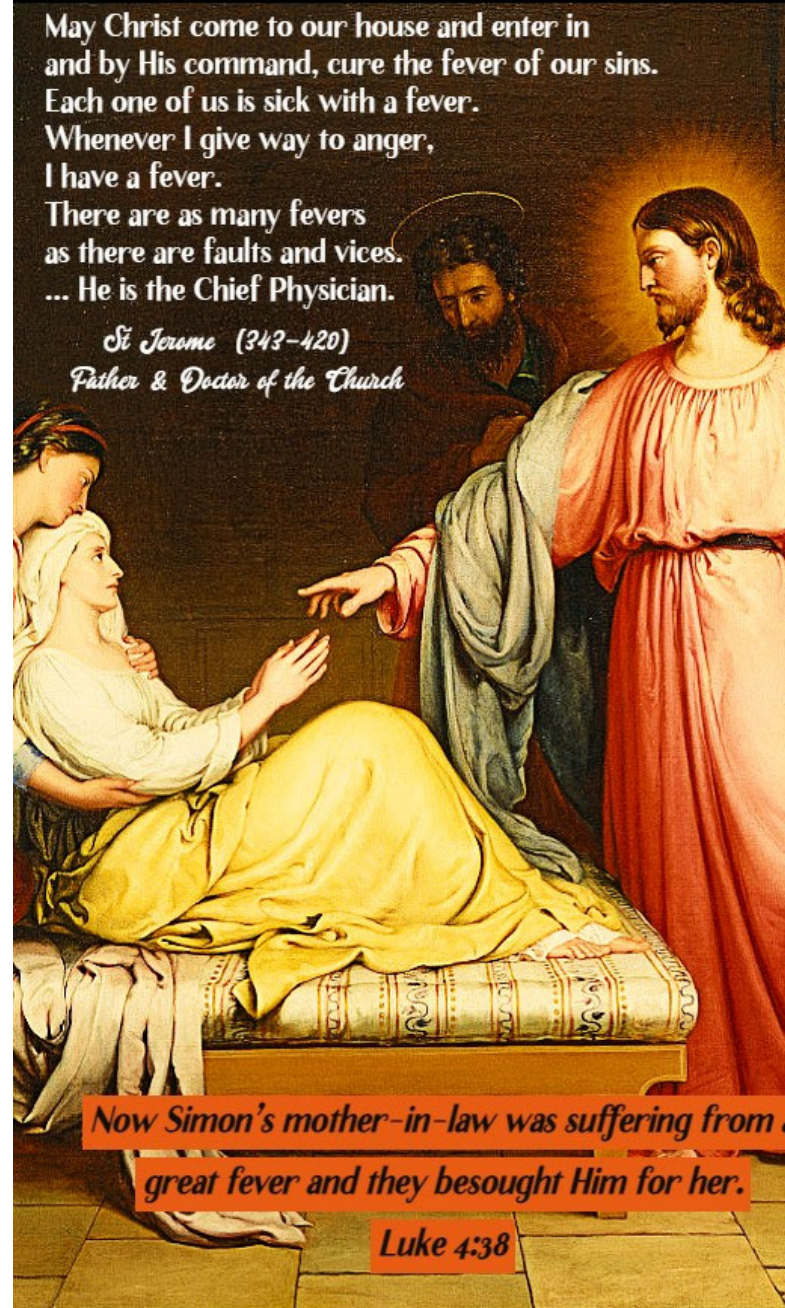
