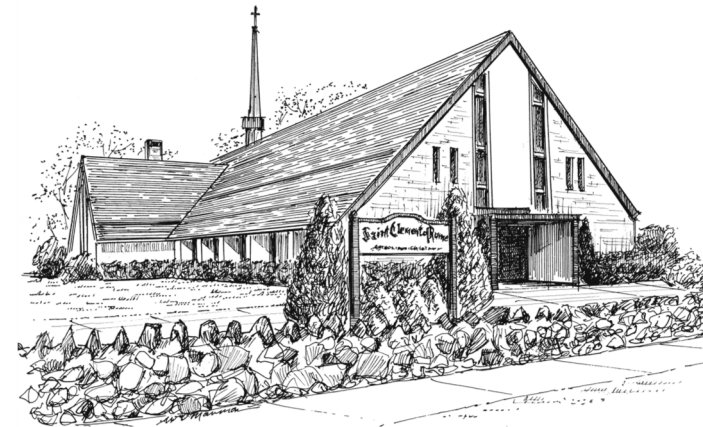

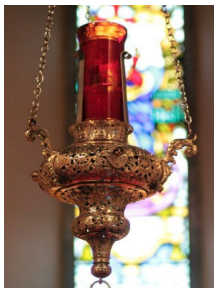

WHAT IS PENTECOST?

Pentecost (from the Greek word "Pentecoste" meaning "50th day") is the one of the most prominent feast days in the Christian calendar. It is often referred to as the "birthday of the Church."

It marks the day, nearly 2,000 years ago, when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles, who had been living in fear for fifty days following the resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday.

Emboldened by the Holy Spirit, the apostles set forth to tell all people in Jerusalem of the Resurrection. As they spoke in tongues given to them by the Holy Spirit, all nationalities present could understand them in their own mother tongue.

PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

Lord Jesus Christ, Savior of the world, through Your most Sacred Heart, we humbly beseech You that You, O eternal pastor would not desert Your flock in its affliction but would refresh it with the spirit which You did so abundantly pour forth upon Your apostles.
