The Catholic Academy of Bridgeport is one school on four campuses in the inner city of Bridgeport -- St. Andrew, St. Ann, St. Augustine and St. Raphael. Its mission is to provide a Christ-centered, academically rigorous learning environment where cultural diversity is welcomed, Catholic values taught and all faiths celebrated. Students are nurtured, encouraged and challenged in preparation for a successful life of leadership and service.

This year the Academy will serve over 900 children. Despite tuition being only \$5,200 a year, 93% of families cannot afford this so the school must award more than \$2.3 million annually in financial assistance. One hundred percent of students graduate from high school 99% go on to attend college or post-secondary school -- outcomes that far exceed Bridgeport charter and public schools.

WHAT IS PENTECOST?



Pentecost (from the Greek word "Pentecoste" meaning "50th day") is the one of the most prominent feast days in the Christian calendar. It is often referred to as the "birthday of the Church."

It marks the day, nearly 2,000 years ago, when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles, who had been living in fear for fifty days following the resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday.

Emboldened by the Holy Spirit, the apostles set forth to tell all people in Jerusalem of the Resurrection. As they spoke in tongues given to them by the Holy Spirit, all nationalities present could understand them in their own mother tongue.

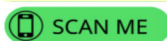
