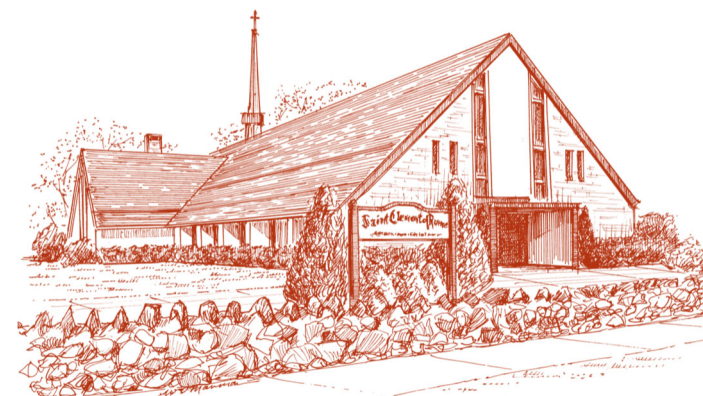

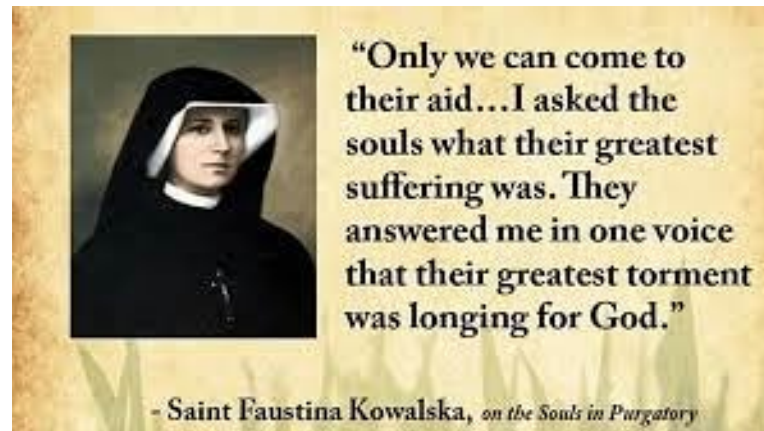

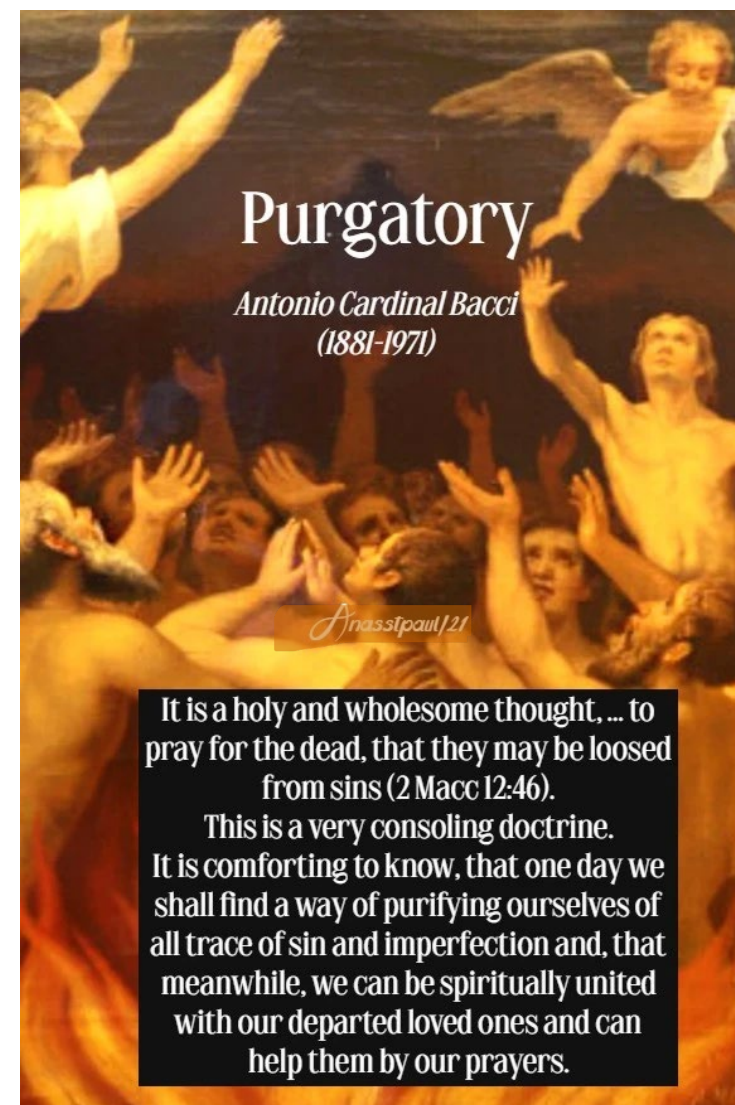
Communion Calls
