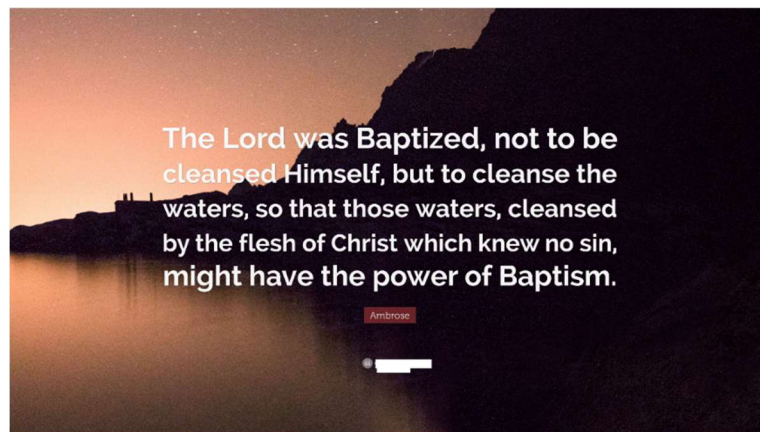

2022 MASS BOOK

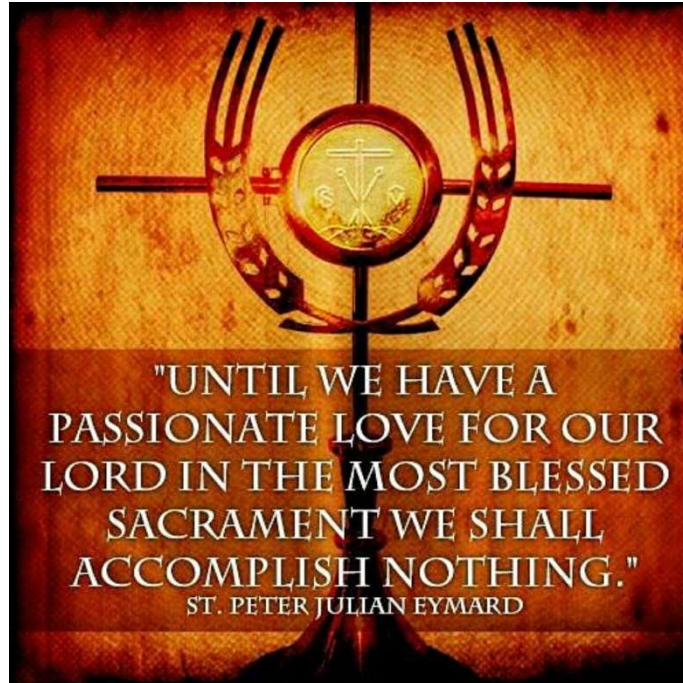
