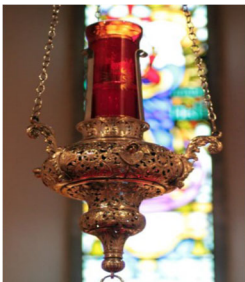

Due to HIPPA privacy regulations, unless we are notified by family member we have no way of knowing that a parishioner has been hospitalized.

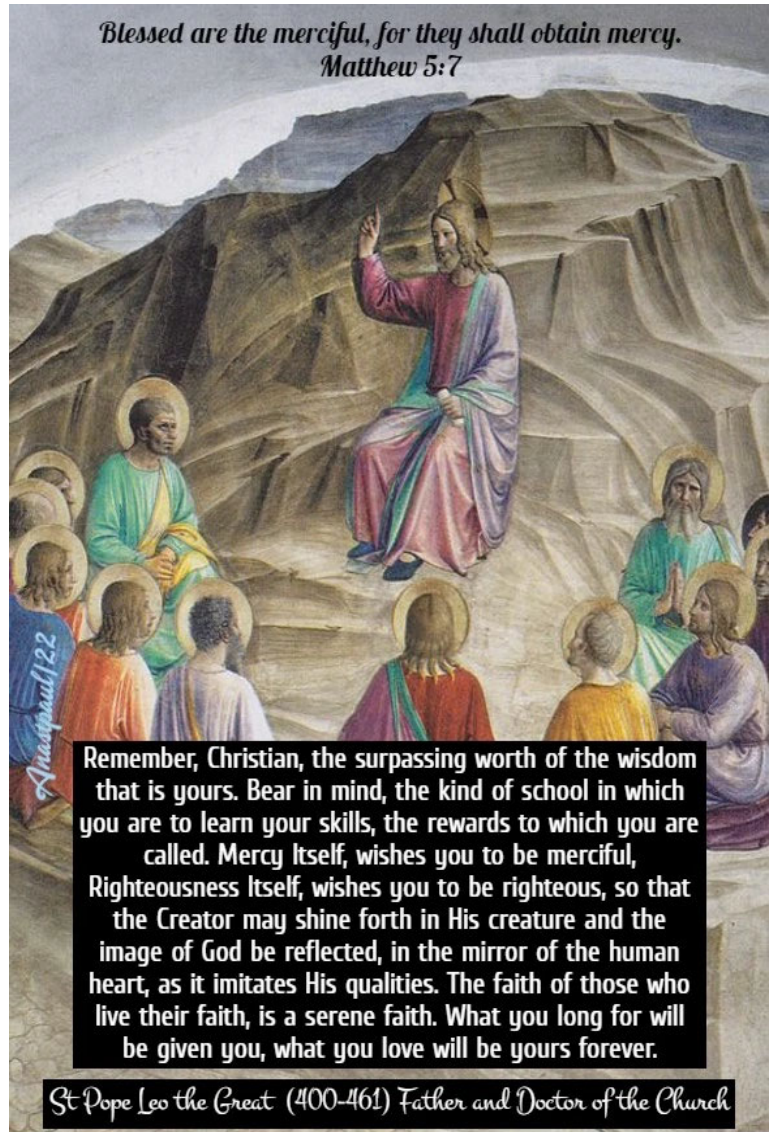
