### *Lent and Easter Duty*



Please remember to have the children receive ashes on Ash Wednesday, February 17th. Ashes will be given at 7:30am, 12:10pm and 5:30pm.

Confession at St. Clement-Saturdays @ 4pm.

Students who already received their First Eucharist, should receive Penance and the Eucharist during Lent.

The sixth and eighth grades will attend the Stations of the Cross on March 26th at 7pm.

With the updated 1983 Code of Canon Law (which sets down the rules for administering and governing the Western Church), the Easter Duty for Catholics currently is stated as an “obligation for the faithful who are already initiated (that is already baptized Catholics) **to receive the Sacraments of Penance and Eucharist during the Easter Season**. In the United States, this has been defined to include the days between the first Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday.” It should be noted that a parish “penance service does not satisfy the requirement for sacramental confession ([CanonLaw.Info](http://CanonLaw.Info), Dr. Edward Peters).
