February 26, 2020 (Day of Fast and Abstinence)

Masses at 7:30 a.m., 12:10 p.m., & 7:00 p.m.

Lent begins with **ASH WEDNESDAY** on February 26th. Ash Wednesday is a day of fast and abstinence. On Ash Wednesday, all Catholics age 14 and older are obliged to abstain from eating meat. All Catholics in good health between the ages of 18 and 60 are also obliged to fast. Fasting means having one full meal and two light meals that day. Eating between meals is not permitted, although drinking fluids is allowed. On Fridays during lent, all Catholics age 14 and older are obliged to abstain from eating meat. Good Friday is a day of Fast and abstinence.
