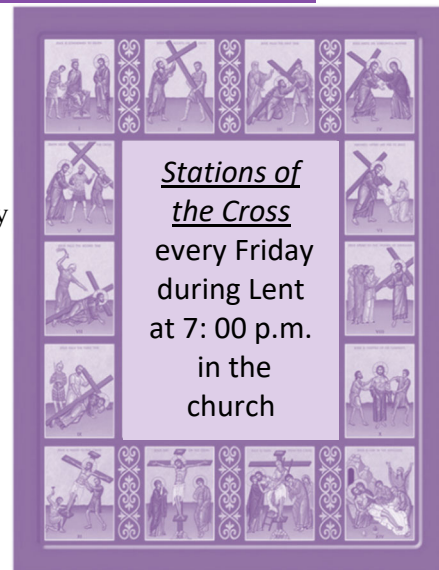

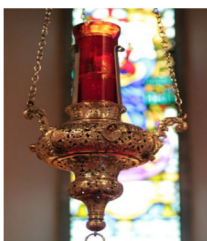

SANCTUARY LAMP

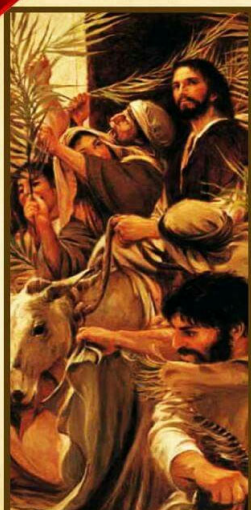


If you would like the Sanctuary Lamp to burn in memory of a loved one; either living or deceased, please call the parish office weekdays between 9am and 2pm for further information.

Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday is the sixth and last Sunday of Lent and marks the beginning of Holy Week.

This day joins the foretelling of Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem (as the crowd welcomed Him with palm branches) and the proclamation of His Passion in the Gospel reading. Hence, the day is called "**Palm Sunday of the Passion of Our Lord.**"

HOSPITAL VISITS

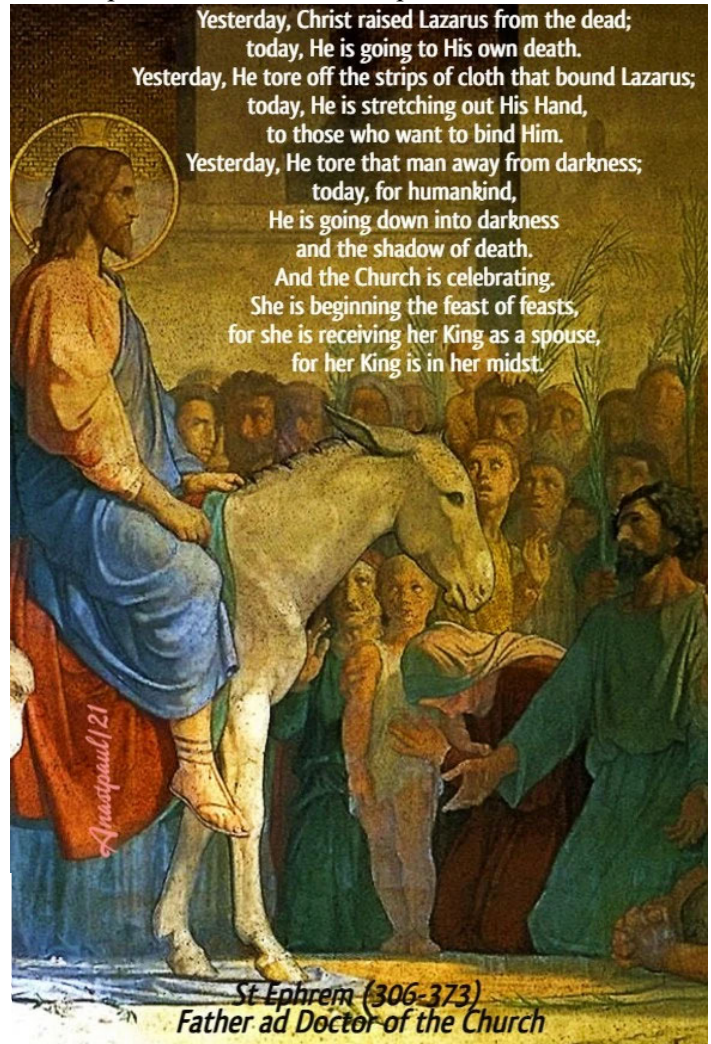
If you or a member of your family are in the hospital or expect to be hospitalized, please call the parish office and let us know.
