### HOSPITAL VISITS

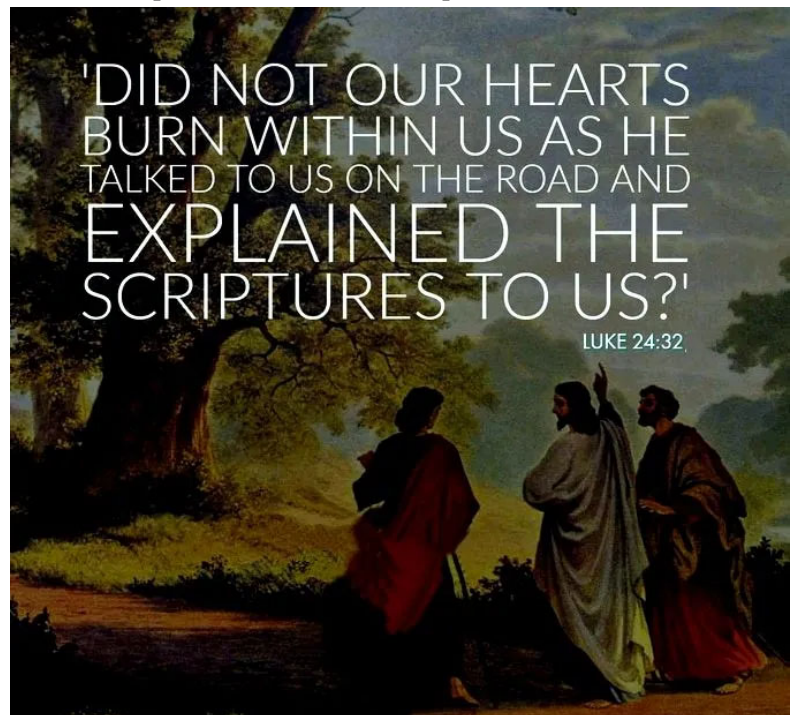
If you or a member of your family are in the hospital or expect to be hospitalized, please call the parish office and let us know.
