Religious Education registration must be in no later than September 1st. First Class is September 8th. If your child was not baptized in St. Clement, and is registered for First Holy Communion, a Baptismal Certificate must be sent in.



A **Third Grade catechist** is needed for the 2019-2020 CCD session. Please call the Religious Education office if you are interested in volunteering each Sunday from 9:20 to 10:25 a.m. Substitute Catechists are also needed. You can enjoy the experience of working with the children without committing to every Sunday morning.

There will be a form to be completed included in your registration package. This form explains the Safe Environment training for students in grades K-12 and parents, which the diocese has put in place. In addition to the diocese, we must also be compliant with the State of Connecticut. Some schools in Connecticut do not include a safe environment program. The diocese has put together a program taught by trained members of our diocese. Please be sure to sign the "Opt Out Form" included and return it to the Religious Education office by December 31, 2019 if you do not want your child to receive training.
