Confirmation Enrollment Mass is scheduled for Sunday, February 21st 8:00am Mass

First Holy Communion Mass is scheduled for Sunday, March 7th 8:00am Mass

Our St. Clement program has 38 students. We are practicing Virtual Learning including Zoom classes and CatholicBrain online. We have the ability to track the student activity to verify their participation in the Sadlier Confirmation Workbook. The First Holy Communion Class has handouts to learn the Reconciliation formula and other symbolic lessons. There are website links emailed home to students for additional information for Advent, Lent, and Sacraments. The Confirmation Class also uses the Sadlier Confirmation Workbook. Since we are a small program, we were able to meet with the Confirmation Class in church and will meet with the other classes live since the classes are composed of 5-6 children. Eighteen students will be confirmed in the Spring and 6 children will receive First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Samantha Saranitti is the Catechist for Grade 6 and Jill DeLeo is the Catechist for the Confirmation Class. Many thanks to these generous volunteers. Connie Figgie and Kay Hedrick volunteered to help out with the Zoom classes which require an extra Virtus trained adult. I teach grades 2,3,4 and 5 due to the lack of volunteer Catechists.
