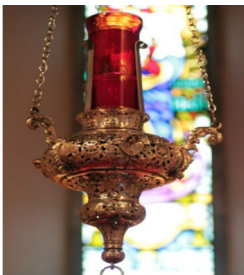


FEAST OF SAINTS

If you know a parishioner who is homebound and would like to receive Communion, please call the parish office and let us know.

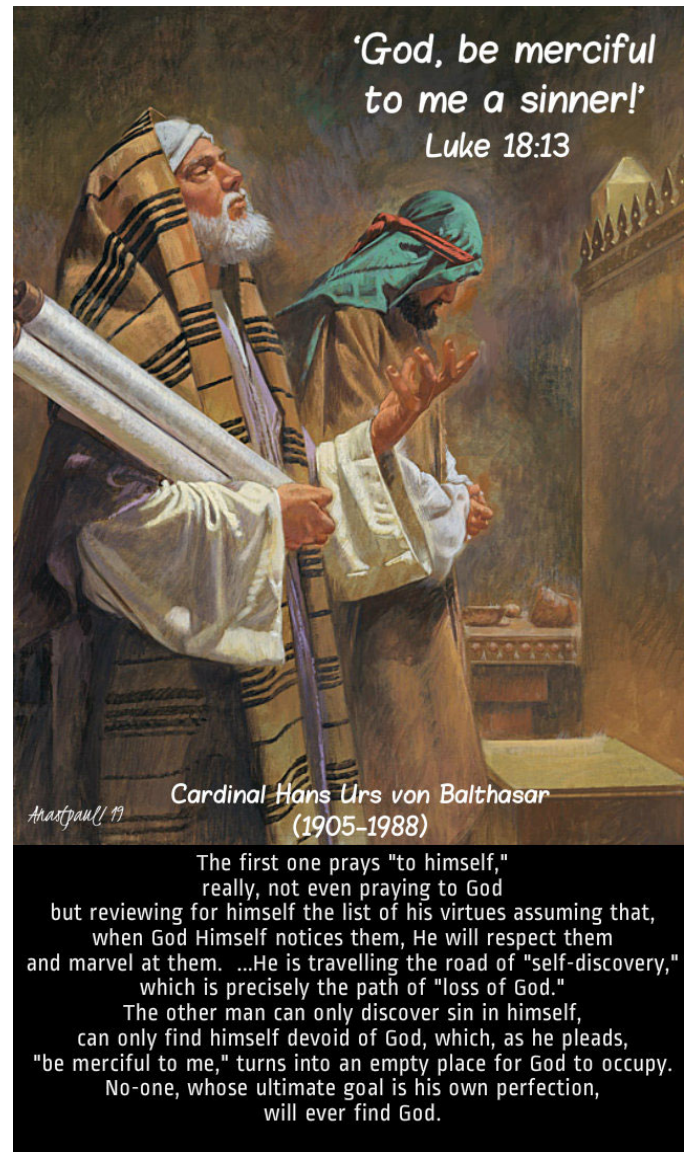


### HOSPITAL VISITS
