From time to time I have sent out links such as <https://www.kidsmartz.org> encouraging parents to use these links as information to train children and young people to be aware of danger and how to deal with questionable situations which may put them in danger. The diocese is nearly complete with a program K-12 which is a well put together Safety Program. When I send out this information, please take time to use the tools to protect our children and teen-agers. Below is an explanation from Erin Neil, L.C.S.W., Director of Safe Environment & Victim Assistance Coordinator.

*"This training includes fun short videos on personal safety. Each lesson helps kids to recognize a safe and trusted adult and be able to spot the tricks used by adults who we may at first think are safe people but may turn out not to be. It is so important for us to be part of that message of safety in this challenging world we live in."*
