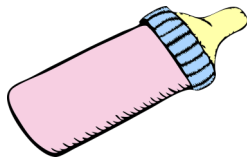

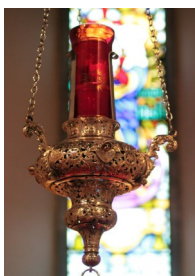
MALTA HOUSE

Please help us fill our baby bottles with your loose change. We have placed collection boxes near the front and back of the church. When you are done filling them up, please place in one of the boxes.

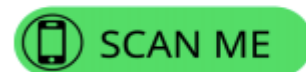
2021 ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL
