

ATTENDANCE:

All children are expected to attend all scheduled classes. Please call the Religious Education office if your child is going to be absent. Excessive absences may result in your child repeating the year.

If your child is diagnosed with a communicable disease, please notify the Religious Education office immediately.

PLEASE have your child in his/her classroom a few minutes before class is scheduled to begin. Teachers need to complete their lesson each week and if teaching cannot begin on time individual classes may not be ready to dismiss on time. For safety, no student will be allowed in a classroom if the teacher is not present.

School building doors will be locked 15 minutes after classes begin in order to insure the safety of students and teachers.

Your children are being taught by volunteers who generously give of their time and talents. Please be considerate and appreciative of their commitment to help enrich the spiritual life of each student. We hope that parents will encourage their children to behave properly in the classroom. If a discipline problem does occur the parents will be notified.

Confirmation students will report to the Parish Office @ 5:45pm on Thursday evenings

EARLY DISMISSAL — Child must be picked up in the classroom.

****** It is mandatory that parish children attend classes every year beginning in the first grade in order to receive their sacraments at the correct grade level. For First Holy Communion classes are from grades 1-3 and the sacrament will be received at the end of Grade 3. Those wishing to receive Confirmation must have a record of attending grades 1-8. Transfers from other parishes or dioceses must have certificates validating their Baptism, First Holy Communion and Faith Formation training.

(A letter from a previous DRE will be sufficient to attest to your Faith Formation background.)

Students being Home Schooled will receive the live stream classroom and will meet with the DRE as each student is scheduled during the year.

MASS ATTENDANCE is an integral part of your child's faith formation. Mass attendance goes hand in hand with the Religious Education Program. One cannot do the work of the other. If your family is not already worshipping regularly, you are invited most sincerely to join us each week in the celebration of the Mass. Religious education classes have a strong reference to the Mass making it difficult for both the teacher and student if they are not regularly participating in the celebration of the Mass. To be eligible to be a part of a sacramental preparation program, a child must attend Mass regularly.

PRAYERS

Students entering Grade 2 must know the Sign of the Cross. Hail Mary, and the Our Father.

Confirmation Candidates must know the above, the Act of contrition and Apostles Creed.
