Our parish's goal is \$468,953 including our 2019 Annual Catholic Appeal. Now that we have satisfied our ACA commitment, 50% of the **We Stand With Christ** funds raised will remain with our parish, while 50% will fund separately incorporated endowments supporting Catholic Education, works of charity, and pastoral ministries throughout Fairfield County

Early gifts from the most participatory families in the parish indicate the success of the campaign overall. Given the positive response so far, we look forward to St. Clement meeting its goal and completing the outlined priorities over the next five years.
